During emergencies, NC State's Emergency Notification Systems will be activated to alert the campus community. Receive notifications via:

- Alertus desktop notifier
- Billboard

## **Emergency Evacuation Assembly Areas**



Leave the building immediately via the nearest exit. Do not re-enter the building until authorized by emergency responders. Assemble in this designated location:



#### **Severe Weather Shelter Areas**



In the event of a tornado or severe weather, seek shelter inside a sturdy building, on the lowest floor possible, away from windows and doors. Seek shelter in this designated



## **Automated External Defibrillator (AED)**



If you see someone collapse, immediately dial 911 or 919.515.3000. Have someone retrieve an AED. Start chest compressions immediately-push hard, fast and deep in the center of the chest. Apply AED pads and follow all voice prompts. An AED is located in:

### In an emergency, dial 911 or 919.515.3000 An emergency is any adverse event where you may require some support or assistance



such as:

- Medical incident
- · Hazardous materials spill/release
- Active shooter
- Fire

- Utility failure
- Suspicious persons
- Concerning behavior
- Bomb threat
